Attendance

The programme will be delivered as follows:

- Induction webinar - 1 hour
- Tutorial webinars - 4 x 1 hour
- One to one tutorials - 4 x 1 hour
- One-to-one supervision sessions - 2 x 1 hour
- 3 x 2 days course attendance

Course Content

Learning will be delivered through group learning, action learning and one-to-one tutorials. Content will include:

- Foundations of leadership coaching
- Goal setting and commitment

- Planning and practice

- Group sessions, pre- and post-session learning

They should have successfully completed an ILM Level 5 qualification in Management, or higher, or have an equivalent qualification. Exceptional learners with no formal qualification in management, but who have several years' experience and have completed some formal training in the role, may also participate.

What qualification(s) can be gained?

On successful completion of the programme and assignments you will receive the ILM Level 7 Diploma in Executive Coaching and Mentoring. This is a level 7 postgraduate qualification.

If you opt to deliver only 20 coaching hours you will only be eligible for the Postgraduate Certificate. For the Postgraduate Diploma you will need to undertake 100 coaching hours.
